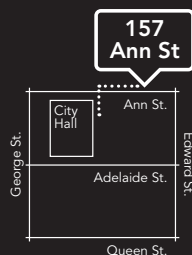

## ABOUT THE AWARDS

The 2010 Lord Mayor's Photographic Awards are a unique opportunity for photographers of any age and experience to become involved in Brisbane's cultural life. There are cash prizes on offer and the winning photograph in the Open category will become part of the City of Brisbane Collection.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

You may portray any aspect of Brisbane – images that capture elements of our daily life, the diverse and multicultural communities of Brisbane or natural or man-made environment.

The judges are looking for creative and innovative entries that capture the spirit of Brisbane life.

Entrants are sought nationally and the judging panel will select a shortlist from each category. The judging panel will then consider the shortlisted works from which the prize winners will be selected.

## ENTRY SUBMISSIONS

- Each entrant may only submit one work.
- Entries may be colour or black and white.
- All artworks must be able to be reproduced in **large format** (up to 3 metres wide and high).
- For reproduction purposes you must supply your entry as a digital file in either JPG or TIF format at a minimum of A3 size at 300DPI on CD/DVD.
- CD/DVD copies must be clearly labelled with name of entrant and title of work.
- Please include an **artist statement** of up to 50 words on the CD/DVD.

## WINNERS ANNOUNCEMENT

Lord Mayor Campbell Newman will announce all award winners on Friday 8 October 2010.

Winning entries will be on display in King George Square.

Friday 8 October - Sunday 31 October 2010.

# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

## 1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Entry is open to all Australian residents.
- 1.2 All photographs must have been taken within the City of Brisbane boundaries.
- 1.3 Entries are limited to one photograph. Entrants must specify on their entry form which category they wish to be considered for.
- 1.4 Images must have been taken after 1 January 2008.
- 1.5 Entries must be the original work of the entrant. No third party may enter on behalf of an individual.
- 1.6 Any entry depicting people must include permission from the subject(s). Entrant must be able to produce evidence of such permission if required.

## 2. How to Enter

- 2.1 All entries must be accompanied by a completed official entry form.
- 2.2 Entries should be hand-delivered between 10am and 5pm to the Customer Service Counter at Museum of Brisbane, Ground Floor, 157 Ann Street, Brisbane or mailed to: *2010 Lord Mayor's Photographic Awards* Museum of Brisbane, GPO Box 1434, Brisbane QLD 4001. Postal entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date of Friday 27 August 2010. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost or misdirected entries.
- 2.3 For all entries, MoB will only accept digital files (JPG or TIF format at a minimum of A3 size at 300DPI) able to be reproduced up to 3 metres in width and height.
- 2.4 Please note entries should not include prints, be framed or mounted.
- 2.5 CD/DVD should be labelled on the reverse with the category, title of work, photograph orientation and the entrants name, address and contact details.
- 2.6 Personal information provided in the entry form will not be disclosed without your consent for any other purpose unless required by the law.

## 3. Judging & Prizes

- 3.1 All entries will be judged by a panel who will consider elements of creativity and originality. There will only be one winner in each category.
- 3.2 The Lord Mayor will announce winners on Friday 8 October 2010.
- 3.3 Prizes are as stated in the entry brochure.
- 3.4 The decision of the judges will be final.
- 3.5 Short-listed entries in all categories will be notified by phone, letter or email and invited to the Lord Mayor's Announcement event on Friday 8 October 2010.
- 3.6 Council and sponsor employees may enter the awards, however they will not be eligible for prizes.
- 3.7 Based on popular vote, one photograph in the exhibition will be voted the ourbrisbane.com People's Choice Award, during the exhibition.

## 4. Exhibition

- 4.1 Selected entries will be exhibited as part of the *2010 Lord Mayor's Photographic Awards* exhibition on King George Square, Brisbane from Friday 8 October to 31 October 2010.
- 4.2 Entrants whose photographs are selected for the exhibition will be notified by letter or email.
- 4.3 Council reserves the right to refuse to display any entry deemed unsuitable for public exhibition.

## 5. Copyright and Moral Rights

- 5.1 You grant Museum of Brisbane the right to:
  - 5.1.1 Maintain a copy of the artwork for archival purposes only.
  - 5.1.2 Enlarge and adapt the artwork in order to fit the large scale format of the exhibition.
  - 5.1.3 Exhibit the artwork on King George Square between Friday 8 October to Sunday 31 October 2010 as part of the exhibition.
- 5.2 You warrant that you are the owner of all copyright in the artwork or have obtained all necessary approvals to permit the use of the artwork in the exhibition.

- 5.3 While you retain copyright of the image, you grant permission for the image to be used to for promotional and publicity purposes relating to the 2010 Awards. All future use of the artwork would be subject to your approval (excluding winner of Open Category).
- 5.4 Museum of Brisbane will acknowledge you in all publicity of the exhibition as the creator and owner of the work.
- 5.6 While Museum of Brisbane will take care to ensure the quality and integrity of the reproduced artwork, you acknowledge that enlargements and slight variations to the artwork may result from adapting the original artwork to the large scale format required for exhibition presentation.
- 5.7 Winning artwork in the Open category will enter the City of Brisbane Collection. You agree and give permission for the work to be reproduced and/or exhibited by Museum of Brisbane in the future.

## 6. Large Format Reproduced artworks

- 6.1 Large format artworks will remain the property of Museum of Brisbane until Sunday 31 October 2010.
- 6.2 Museum of Brisbane will refer all sale enquiries to the entrant.
- 6.3 Following Sunday 31 October 2010, MoB will donate your large format work to you. You must organise and fund the collection of the work. MoB will not donate the large format artwork to you if sold in accordance with 6.2 above.

## 7 Return of Entry Materials

- 7.1 Materials cannot be returned.

**Entries must be received by Museum of Brisbane by 5pm Friday 27 August 2010.**
