# MoB KiDS: EASTER ORNAMENT

This activity is designed especially for kids and grown-ups to do together. Based on MoB's *Bauhaus Now* exhibition, it introduces you to some of the fundamental elements of Bauhaus teaching and doubles as a small gift box to inspire the artist in you this Easter.

## You will need:

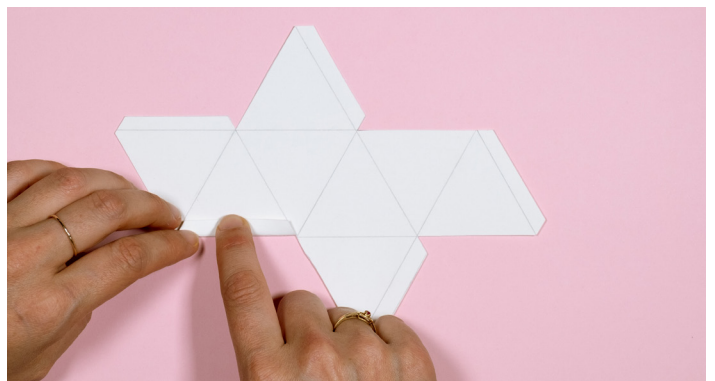
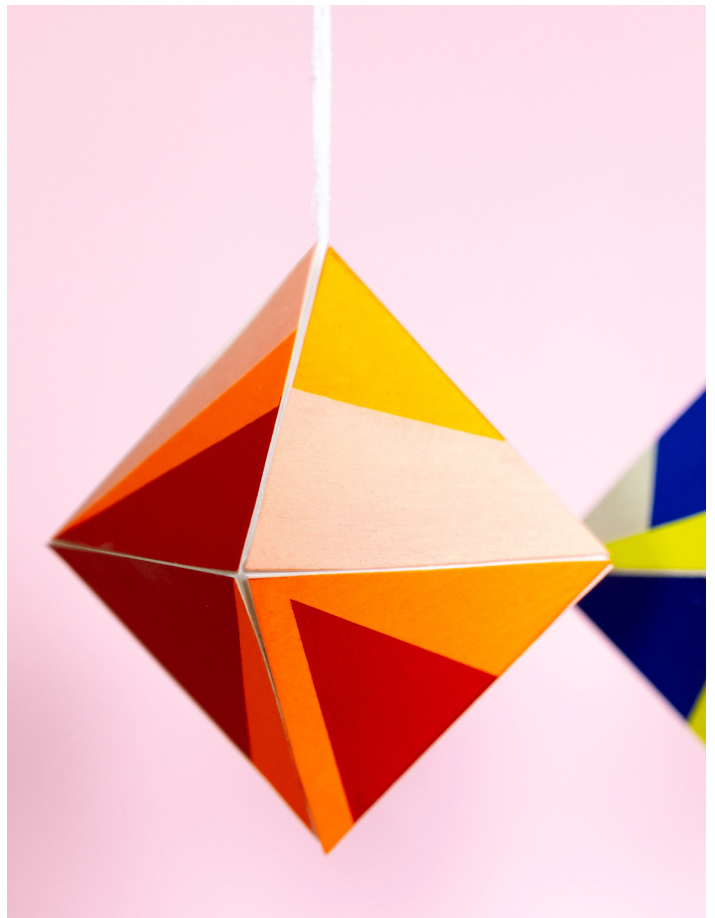
- Template provided in this PDF
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Sticky tape
- Cotton thread
- Glue stick
- 2 A4 sheets of quality paper (1 for printing and 1 for decorating).
- Your favourite materials for decorating, i.e. paint, pastels, coloured pencils, crayons, coloured paper.
- Mini chocolate Easter eggs to hide inside.

## HOW TO:

1. Print the template provided onto a sheet of quality paper.
2. Follow the dotted line to cut out the template.
3. With the stencil facing up, fold each of the tabs inwards and press firmly.
4. Fold each of the triangle edges in the same direction.

*Note: Create a crisp fold line using the end of your pencil.*

5. Flip the template over and set aside.

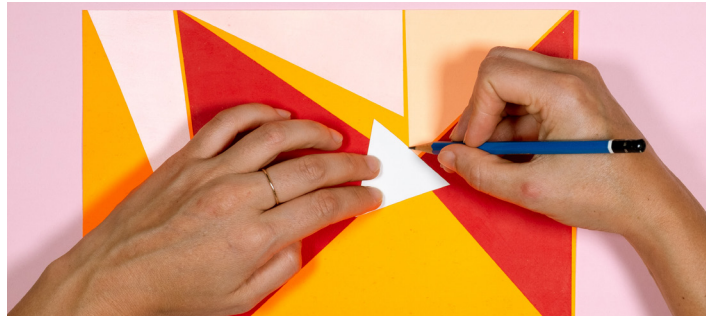

## Decorate

6. Add colour to your second piece of paper and allow to dry.

*Note: There is no wrong way of adding colour to paper. We chose a geometric design inspired by the Bauhaus. Basic elements of colour, shape, and line were essential to Bauhaus teaching. Embrace the spirit of the Bauhaus and experiment to create a design using basic elements.*



## Form

7. Position the triangle stencil over your favourite section.
8. Trace around the stencil and cut out the shape.
9. Repeat to create eight colourful triangles.
10. Apply glue to the triangle segments on the template.
11. Press your coloured triangles onto the segments and allow to dry.
12. Flip the template over and attach a loop of cotton thread to the inside using sticky tape.

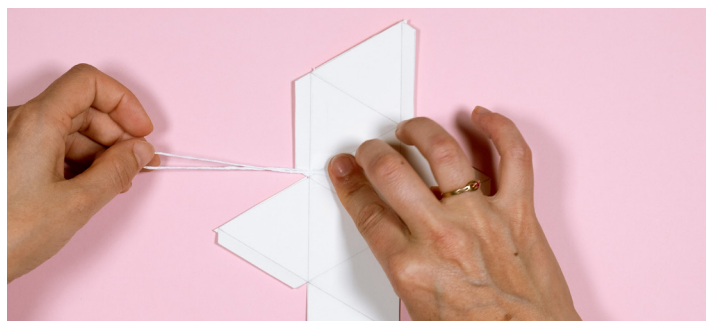
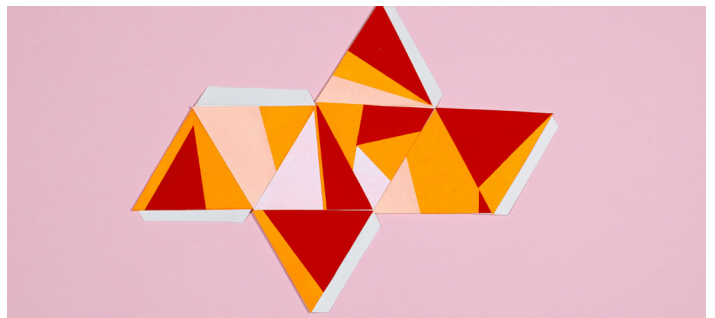


## Fold

13. With the colourful side facing up, apply glue to each tab.
14. Fold up the ornament, tucking the tabs inside as you go.

*Note: The paper will easily find its shape due to the folding you did earlier.*

15. Hold each tab in place for a few seconds until the glue sets.
16. Pop your mini Easter eggs inside before gluing the final tab.
