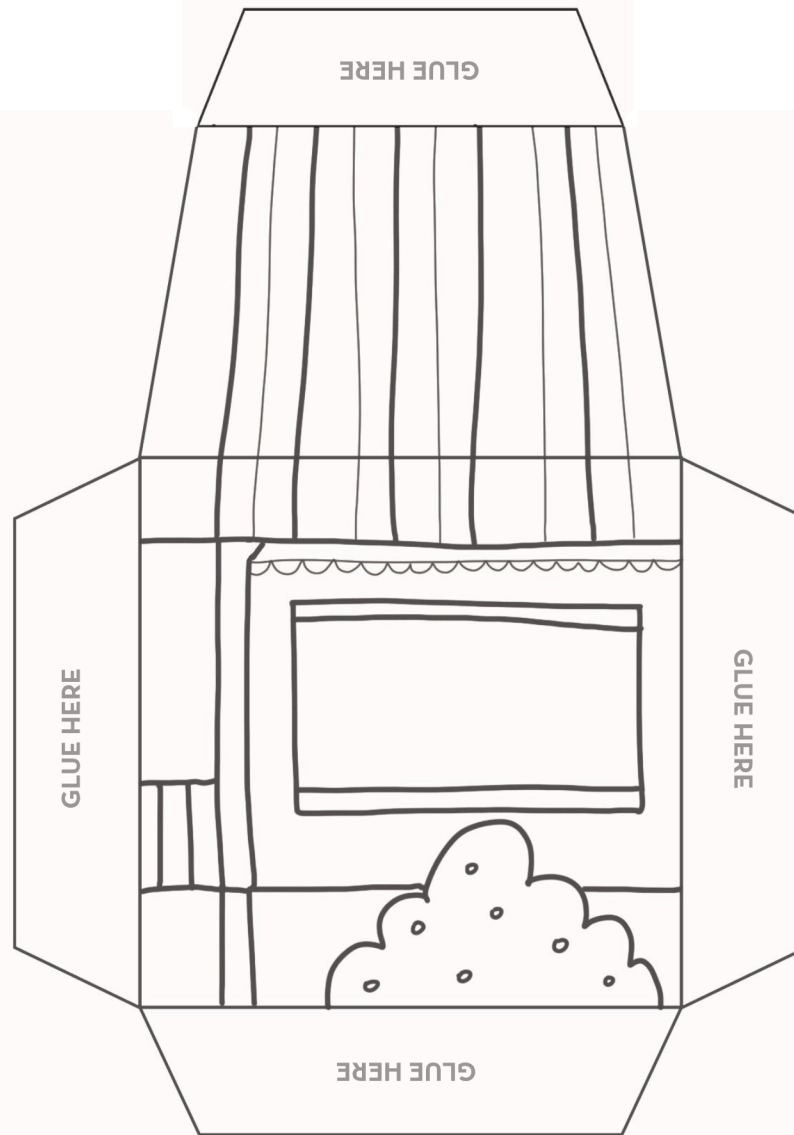


DREAM BUILD

Don't forget to draw your family, pets or favourite bedroom treasures in the window!

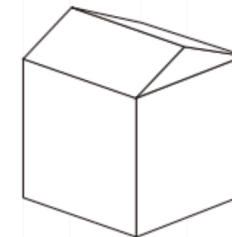

WHAT MAKES A QUEENSLANDER UNIQUE?

A Queenslander has four core elements: a hardwood frame with soft linings; a verandah; made mainly of timber and tin; and most distinctively is raised above the ground.

There are lots of good reasons to place Queenslanders on stumps, it helps to keep you cool in summer allowing breeze to flow under the house, makes it easy to build on sloping land, sits high above damaging flood waters, and keeps the timber away from pesky termites. Under the house is also a great place for playing out of the sun, hanging the washing, and hiding from chores!
